

School Readiness Goals and Outcome

Korean American Community Services Early Childhood Center established our school readiness goals pertaining to the knowledge and skills children demonstrate in five major areas of development. These five areas of development are aligned with the *Head Start Child Development and Early Learning Framework* (HSCDELFF): Social and Emotional Development; Language Development and Literacy; Approaches to Learning; Cognition and General Knowledge; and Physical Well-Being and Motor Development. School readiness goals allow our teachers to implement a plan of action to support all children meeting these goals. Output is determined through the use of the GOLD Readiness Report for Kindergarten Entry. Teachers assess children's development and learning on an ongoing basis and analyze data four times a year. Teachers examine this data for patterns of progress in children in order to best meet children at their level and plan for further growth.

We worked with all pre-K children to achieve school readiness goals through the year. By the end of the summer, all teachers found their pre-K children were ready to go on to kindergarten based on the GOLD Readiness Report for Kindergarten Entry. In each checkpoint period, teachers analyzed children's individual needs and accomplishments based on the five major areas of development. Teachers provided a variety of activities for small group and individual instructional activities that supported and scaffolded children's development and learning. During the summer months, we focused on transition activities and monitored children's strengths and weaknesses to ensure that all children would meet their readiness goals. We worked cooperatively with parents to support children in their preparations for kindergarten. We encouraged and supported children to be socially and emotionally ready and prepared for kindergarten to have positive expectations for their new schools.
